
# Sentence Sequences

For Complex Sentence Development



Practice producing and comprehending complex sentences using prepositions and conjunctions such as before, after, when, while and during.



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#### Sentence Sequences for Complex Sentence Development

Two activities are presented on these cards for producing and understanding complex sentences. The activities review words such as; before, after, when, while, during, and because. In order to do this activity, the student will need to consider which information is important, hold information into memory, think about time sequence, and then manipulate the ideas into one sentence.



The red diamond side of the cards contain sentence sequences that will need to be used to make complex sentences with the proper connecting words to retain the meaning. Instruct students that they will need to replace parts of the sentence with pronouns to reduce duplication in the sentence.



The blue arrowed side of the cards contain three example sentences made from the red diamond side. However, one of the sentences does not have the same meaning as the other two or is an incorrect use of the words. The student is instructed to find the incorrect sentence. The answer can be checked by scanning the QR code in the lower right corner of the card or using the following answer sheet. Students can correct the error sentence for additional practice.

There are 11 card pages for a total of 33 cards with a front and back side. The red diamond and blue arrow cards are printed side by side. If you do not cut the middle line, you can fold one card to the back so it becomes two sided. You can glue or laminate them together to make one sturdy card. You may also want to cut them apart for other activities for a total of 66 cards. They are meant to be printed onto card stock.


