
# Irregular Past Tense Verb Task Cards



Self Checking with QR code




- This set contains 10 pages of cards for a total of 30 two sided cards, 2½ inches by 3 inches when folded. They are best printed on cardstock. Cards are set up so that the horizontal lines are cut to divide cards. The vertical lines are folded. The right side card is folded under the left side, providing the answer to the prompt on the top. You may want to glue them together to make a sturdier card.
- They are self checking. If you have a UV pen you can write the answers in the blue boxes. The answer will be invisible until students light them up.
- The QR codes also provide answers. There are a variety of apps for mobile devices that provide a bar code reader.
- I made these cards for students working on irregular past tense verbs to elicit the verbs within a natural sentence context. I wanted students to do more than memorize words according to what happened today and yesterday. My commercial cards have pictures that don't reflect the past event and also print the word below. These cards are meant to solve those two problems by having the printed word hidden and providing a picture that reflects the past tense.
- The cards may also be used for interpreting and answering questions that use the words before, after, during and while. They can be used for making predictions when given a context.




